The 8<sup>th</sup>Iberian International Business Conference aims to bring together the growing number of Portuguese and Spanish scholars researching actively in topics related to Multinationals, Foreign Direct Investment, Internationalisation and Exporting of both large firms and SMEs. The event therefore tries to provide a privileged forum to discuss recent work done by researchers in the interdisciplinary areas of international business, international marketing and international entrepreneurship. Papers do not need to be focused on Portugal or Spain, although these are welcome. Accepted papers will be included in a CD-Rom of Conference Proceedings.

### **Guest speaker**

Opening speech will be by professor Gary A. Knight with the title "Small and Medium Enterprises in International Business". He will speak on the role of SMEs in international business, especially as this pertains to economic development of national economies.

Gary Knight is currently a professor of Marketing and International Business at Florida State University, but from August 2012 he will take up a position as the Helen Simpson Jackson Chair in International Business at the Atkinson Graduate School of Management, Willamette University, Salem, Oregon. Professor Knight is ranked one of the top 15 most prolific scholars in the United States, and one of the top 30 worldwide, in the six leading international business journals. He is also ranked in the top five percent of scholars who have published in the Journal of International Business Studies since 1995, based on number of articles published.
